


DEED OF VARIATION TO THE FUNDING AGREEMENT

THIS DEED is made the 22 day of  2019

BETWEEN

- 1) The Secretary of State for Education (the "**Secretary of State**"); and
- 2) The Somerset Road Education Trust, (the "**Company**") a charitable company incorporated in England and Wales with registered number 09343767, together, the "**Parties**".

INTRODUCTION

- A. The Parties entered into a funding agreement dated on 19th December 2014 which was varied following the Parties entering into a Deed of Variation dated 28th September 2016 (together the "**Funding Agreement**") relating to the establishment, maintenance and funding of Exeter House Special School in accordance with the Funding Agreement.
- B. The Parties now wish to vary and amend certain terms and conditions of the Funding Agreement in accordance with the terms of this Deed.
- C. This Deed is supplemental to the Funding Agreement.

1. INTERPRETATION

- 1.1 Words, expressions and interpretations used in this Deed shall, unless the context expressly requires otherwise, have the meaning given to them in, and shall be interpreted in accordance with, the Funding Agreement.

2. VARIATION OF THE FUNDING AGREEMENT

- 2.1 The Parties agree that with effect from the date of this Deed the Funding Agreement shall be amended as follows:

Clause 4.1 shall be deleted and replaced with:

The planned number of places at the Special Academy is 134 in the age range 2-19, including a sixthform of 22 places and a nursery unit of 0 places. The number of funded places and the age ranges are not determinative of GAG. GAG for each Academy Funding Year will be determined by the Secretary of State in accordance with clauses 54C and 54D of the Master Agreement.

- 2.2 Except as varied by this Deed, the Funding Agreement shall remain in full force and effect.

3. Governing law and jurisdiction

- 3.1 This Deed, and any disputes or claims arising out of or in connection with it, its subject matter or formation (including non-contractual disputes or claims), shall be governed by and construed in accordance with English law.

3.2 The parties irrevocably agree that the English courts have exclusive jurisdiction to settle any dispute or claim that arises out of or in connection with this Deed or its subject matter or formation (including non-contractual disputes or claims).

4. Counterparts

4.1 This Deed may be executed in any number of counterparts and by the parties to it on separate counterparts, each of which when so executed and delivered shall be an original, but all the counterparts shall together constitute one and the same instrument.


