Somerset Road Education Trust is a unique collaborative multi-academy trust, formed in partnership between Exeter House Special School, St Mark’s CofE Junior School and Wyndham Park Infants’ School, who all share a campus. We also have an offsite vocational centre for our older students between the ages of 14 and 19 with severe learning difficulties, which is part of Exeter House School but based in town.

We have successfully set up two Resource Bases in the last year, one at Wyndham Park Infants’ and one at St Mark’s Junior School, and we plan to expand the base at Wyndham Park by a further class, building on the great work that has taken pace over the last year. The Resource Bases are an exciting development for the Trust and the opportunity for children with an EHCP and a primary need of social communication difficulties to have their needs met through access to specialist provision whilst maintaining the benefits of being within and accessing a mainstream setting as and where this is appropriate.

Each resource base has approximately 10 children and a partner base at Exeter House School. Working together as bases and schools we aim to provide an innovative and exciting provision to enhance SEN provision for children in South Wiltshire whilst developing the inclusive aims of all the schools in the Trust. This is a Trust-wide role and whilst you will be predominately working within one of the resource bases there is an expectation that you may work across the Trust.
